Summary

SB1556 mandates the creation of an Advisory Board to oversee AI in education, develop standards, and provide guidance on its use in schools.

Business Impact

If you operate a school district in Illinois, you must report AI usage and comply with new standards by December 31, 2025 or face potential penalties.

Key Provisions

- Establishment of the State Instructional Technology Advisory Board to oversee AI in education.
- Development of standards for safety, transparency, data privacy, and educational quality for AI technologies.
- Annual reporting requirement for school districts on AI usage.
- Guidance for educators on the use of AI in teaching and learning.
- Evaluation of commonly used AI tools in schools by the State Board of Education.
- Professional development opportunities for educators on AI implementation.

- Develop and implement AI standards and guidance | Who: State Board of Education and Advisory Board
