## FRAUD-ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE

Last Action (Apr 11, 2025): Rule 3-9(a) / Re-referred to Assignments

### Summary

This bill mandates generative AI systems to display warnings about potential inaccuracies, with non-compliance classified as an unlawful practice.

### Business Impact

If you operate a generative AI system in Illinois, you must display user warnings about output accuracy or face penalties.

### Key Provisions

- Operators of generative AI systems must display a warning on the user interface.
- The warning must inform users that outputs may be inaccurate or inappropriate.
- Violations of this requirement are considered unlawful practices under the Act.

### Compliance Checklist

- Display a conspicuous warning about output accuracy on the user interface. | Who: Owners, licensees, or operators of generative AI systems. | Penalty: Considered an unlawful practice under the Consumer Fraud and Deceptive Business Practices Act.
