## FRAUD-ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE

### Summary

This bill mandates that generative AI systems display warnings about potential inaccuracies in their outputs.

### Business Impact

If you operate a generative AI system in Illinois, you must display a warning about output accuracy or face penalties.

### Key Provisions

- Generative AI systems must display a warning about potential inaccuracies in outputs.
- The warning must be conspicuous and effectively inform users.
- Violations of this requirement are considered unlawful practices under the Consumer Fraud Act.

### Compliance Checklist

- Display a warning about output accuracy on the user interface | Who: Owners, licensees, or operators of generative AI systems | Penalty: Considered an unlawful practice under the Act
