Summary

This bill prohibits using AI for scoring teacher evaluations but allows their use for administrative support tasks.

Business Impact

If you evaluate teachers in Illinois, you must not use AI for scoring evaluations or face potential compliance issues.

Key Provisions

- Prohibits AI use for assigning scores or ratings in teacher evaluations.
- Allows AI tools for administrative support tasks.
- Emphasizes the importance of professional judgment in evaluations.

Compliance Checklist

- Ensure AI tools are not used for scoring teacher evaluations. | Who: School evaluators and administrators. | Penalty: Potential compliance issues or challenges in evaluation practices.
- Utilize AI tools only for administrative support, not for evaluations. | Who: School districts and evaluators. | Penalty: Potential compliance issues or challenges in evaluation practices.
