Summary

SB2909 prohibits the use of AI tools for scoring teacher evaluations but allows their use for administrative support.

Business Impact

If you evaluate teachers in Illinois, you must not use AI tools for scoring evaluations or face potential compliance issues.

Key Provisions

- Prohibits evaluators from using AI to assign scores or ratings in teacher evaluations.
- Allows AI to assist evaluators in administrative tasks.
- Maintains the importance of professional judgment in evaluations.

Compliance Checklist

- Ensure AI tools are not used for scoring teacher evaluations. | Who: School district evaluators. | Penalty: Potential challenges in evaluation processes.
- Disclose any AI tool used in evaluations to the teacher. | Who: Evaluators. | Penalty: Failure to disclose may lead to compliance issues.
