### Summary

The bill allows the State Board of Education to provide guidance on workforce development curricula for teaching AI and other technologies in schools.

### Business Impact

If you operate a school in Illinois, you must consider adopting the State Board's guidance on AI education to prepare students for future job opportunities.

### Key Provisions

- State Board of Education may provide guidance on workforce development curricula.
- Focus on teaching artificial intelligence, quantum computing, and other technologies.
- Comprehensive review of technology curricula from other states shall be prepared.
- Stakeholder meetings and public comments encouraged in guidance preparation.
