Business Impact

If you operate in AI or automation in New York, you must stay informed about potential regulations by December 31, 2026, or risk non-compliance.

Key Provisions

- Establishes a temporary commission to study AI, robotics, and automation regulation.
- Exact number of commission members to be confirmed from the full bill text.
- Final report's due date to be confirmed from the full bill text.
