## Summary

Requires entities using AI in New York to file scaling policies with the CIO, covering all businesses offering products to consumers in the state.

## Business Impact

If you use AI in New York, you must file a scaling policy annually or face audits.

## Key Provisions

- Entities using AI must develop a responsible capability scaling policy.
- Annual compliance certification must be filed with the CIO, who may also be the chief cyber officer.
- The CIO may issue waivers or exemptions, involving designating categories of entities that are covered or exempt, with authority available on the secretary of state's website.
- The Attorney General can audit filed policies.
- Joint filing with cybersecurity compliance if applicable.
- CIO to promulgate rules and regulations for implementation.
