Summary

This bill amends the penal law to include AI-generated communications in the definition of falsely reporting an incident in the third degree.

Business Impact

If you use AI to generate communications in New York, you must ensure accuracy to avoid misdemeanor charges.

Key Provisions

- Incorporates AI-generated communications into the definition of falsely reporting an incident.
- Assumes scenarios where AI usage can lead to charges of false reporting.
- Assumes penalties for individuals or entities that misuse AI in reporting incidents.
