## Summary

This bill prohibits AI-generated transcripts of video conference meetings without conspicuous disclosure during the meeting that AI transcription may occur.

## Business Impact

If you conduct video conferences in New York, you must disclose if AI will transcribe the meeting or face potential penalties.

## Key Provisions

- Prohibits AI transcription of video conferences without conspicuous disclosure.
- Requires conspicuous disclosure during the meeting.
