## Summary

This bill prohibits AI from transcribing video conference meetings without clear disclosure to participants.

## Business Impact

If you conduct video conferences in New York, you must disclose AI transcription capabilities during the meeting or face legal consequences.

## Key Provisions

- Prohibits AI transcription of video conferences without disclosure.
- Requires conspicuous notice to all participants regarding AI transcription.

## Compliance Checklist

- Provide conspicuous disclosure of AI transcription during video conferences. | Who: Organizations conducting video conferences. | Penalty: Potential legal consequences for non-compliance.
