Relating to a prohibition on the use of artificial intelligence technology for classroom instruction.

Summary

SB382 suggests prohibiting AI in Texas classrooms based on its title and description. The full bill text is unavailable, limiting verification of details.

Business Impact

If you use AI for classroom instruction, you must prepare for potential prohibition.

Key Provisions

- Proposes prohibiting AI technology for classroom instruction based on the title and description.
- Specific exceptions, penalties, and definitions are unverified without the full bill text.
- Legislative sponsors and process stages should be verified through legislative tracking resources.
- The scope of 'classroom instruction' and 'artificial intelligence technology' are undefined without the full text.
