

# HB4455 • Texas

Relating to the use of artificial intelligence by health care providers.

## Summary

This bill regulates the use of artificial intelligence by health care providers in Texas, requiring disclosure and responsible use.

## Business Impact

If you are a health care provider in Texas using AI, you must comply with new regulations by September 1, 2025, or face potential penalties.

## Key Provisions

- Defines 'artificial intelligence' and 'health care provider'.
- Requires the executive commissioner to regulate AI use by health care providers.
- Mandates disclosure of AI usage to patients through automated messaging.
- Requires contact information for a health care provider to address patient concerns.
- Establishes compliance deadline of September 1, 2025.

## Compliance Checklist

- Adopt rules for responsible AI use in health care services. | Who: Executive commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission. | Penalty: Unspecified penalties for non-compliance.
- Disclose AI usage to patients via automated messaging. | Who: Health care providers. | Penalty: Unspecified penalties for non-compliance.
