Relating to the use of artificial intelligence to score certain portions of assessment instruments administered to public school students.

Summary

Prohibits AI scoring of student assessments unless specific criteria are met, focusing on training, validity, and bias prevention.

Business Impact

If you use AI for scoring in Texas schools, you must meet criteria by 2025 or face prohibition.

Key Provisions

- Prohibits AI scoring of constructed responses unless criteria are met.
- Requires AI training on diverse student samples.
- Mandates independent evaluation and certification of AI scoring methods.
