Relating to biometric identifiers used in the performance of artificial intelligence.

Summary

This bill amends Texas law regarding biometric identifiers used in artificial intelligence, focusing on identification and data use.

Business Impact

If you use biometric data for AI in Texas, you must ensure compliance with identification rules by September 1, 2025, or face penalties.

Key Provisions

- Defines 'artificial intelligence' and 'biometric identifier'.
- Regulates the use of biometric identifiers in AI applications.
- Exempts certain uses of AI from biometric regulations unless for identification.
- Takes effect on September 1, 2025.

Compliance Checklist

- Ensure biometric data is used solely for identification in AI. | Who: Businesses using biometric identifiers for AI. | Penalty: Subject to penalties for non-compliance.
- Review and update data handling practices for biometric identifiers. | Who: Data compliance officers and business operators. | Penalty: Potential fines for violations.
