Artificial Intelligence Developer Act; established, civil penalty.

Summary

HB747 establishes standards for AI developers and deployers, enforced by the Attorney General with civil penalties. Deployers' standards effective July 1, 2026. The bill is in 'Introduced' status, last noted in the Communications, Technology and Innovation committee.

Business Impact

If you deploy AI in Virginia, you must comply with new standards by July 1, 2026, or face civil penalties.

Key Provisions

- Establishes operating standards for AI developers and deployers.
- Mandates risk avoidance and protection against discrimination.
- Requires disclosures and impact assessments.
- Enforcement by the Office of the Attorney General with civil penalties for non-compliance.
- Delayed effective date for deployers until July 1, 2026.
