Summary

SB3292 aims to support research on digital platforms, with specific details to be confirmed upon full bill text availability.

Business Impact

If you operate a digital platform, you must ensure compliance with data access conditions by January 2025 or face penalties.

Key Provisions

- Mechanisms for privacy-protected, secure pathways for independent research are to be verified upon full bill text availability.
- Specific requirements for data access to ensure responsible and secure research are to be confirmed.
- Involvement of any oversight or regulatory bodies is to be specified upon full bill text availability.
