High-risk artificial intelligence; development, deployment, and use by public bodies, report.

Summary

The bill establishes requirements for high-risk AI systems used by public bodies and mandates a work group to assess local government compliance.

Business Impact

If you operate a public body in Virginia using high-risk AI, you must comply with new regulations by July 1, 2027, or face penalties.

Key Provisions

- Establishes requirements for high-risk AI systems used by public bodies.
- Mandates the CIO to develop, publish, and maintain policies for procurement and assessment of these systems.
- Creates a work group to evaluate local government compliance with the bill.
- Prohibits algorithmic discrimination in the use of high-risk AI systems.
- Requires ongoing assessments of high-risk AI systems.
- Sets a compliance deadline of July 1, 2027.
- Requires a compliance clause in procurement contracts for high-risk AI systems starting July 1, 2027.
