

# SB 24-205 • Colorado

## Colorado Artificial Intelligence Act

Enacted

Risk: High

Effective: Jun 30, 2026

## Summary

The Colorado Artificial Intelligence Act requires governance, reasonable care to prevent algorithmic discrimination, disclosure, impact assessments, and technical documentation for high-risk AI systems.

## Business Impact

If you operate high-risk AI systems in Colorado, you must implement risk management policies and conduct annual assessments by June 30, 2026, or face enforcement actions.

## Key Provisions

- Governance is required for high-risk AI systems.
- Parties involved must exercise reasonable care to prevent algorithmic discrimination.
- Impact assessments, disclosure, and technical documentation are required for compliance.
- The Colorado Attorney General is involved in enforcement.
- High-risk AI systems are defined based on criteria specified in the bill.
