Human services: medical services; use of artificial intelligence tools to make decisions regarding claims; prohibit. Amends 1939 PA 280 (MCL 400.1 - 400.119b) by adding sec. 107b.

Summary

HB 4537 prohibits AI in medical claims decisions in Michigan, amending 1939 PA 280 by adding Section 107b. The bill text lacks compliance requirements or penalties.

Business Impact

If you use AI for medical claims, you must stop upon enactment or face unspecified consequences.

Key Provisions

- Prohibits the use of AI tools for medical claims decision-making (Sec. 107b)

Compliance Checklist

- Cease the use of AI tools for decision-making on medical claims. | Who: Healthcare providers and insurers in Michigan. | Penalty: Potential legal consequences for non-compliance.
