Last Action (Mar 19, 2026): Re-referred To Committee On Communications And Technology

Summary

This bill addresses the use of AI in medical claims processes, but details require verification from the full bill text.

Business Impact

If you operate a health plan in Michigan, you must ensure claims are not reviewed by AI or face potential claim denials.

Key Provisions

- Specific prohibitions regarding AI use need verification.
- Entities affected require confirmation.
- Penalties for non-compliance need to be checked in the bill text.

Compliance Checklist

- Ensure claims are not reviewed by AI tools. | Who: Health plans and the Department of Human Services. | Penalty: Potential claim denials and legal challenges.
