Summary

AB 2392 mandates AI product training for California Community Colleges and CSU, and encourages it for UC, with the bill currently in the Committee on Privacy and Consumer Protection.

Business Impact

If you provide AI products to educational institutions, ensure training is offered before use.

Key Provisions

- Mandates training on AI products for California Community Colleges and California State University.
- Encourages similar training compliance from the University of California.
- Training must occur before the provision of AI products to users.
