## Public postsecondary education: generative artificial intelligence systems: procurement standards: training.

## Summary

AB 2392 mandates training on generative AI systems for California Community Colleges and CSU, requests UC training, requires annual review, and maintaining individual training records as provided.

## Business Impact

If you provide AI products to educational institutions, ensure training is offered before use.

## Key Provisions

- Mandates training on generative AI systems for California Community Colleges and California State University, with annual updates and individual record-keeping as provided.
- Requests similar training compliance from the University of California and requires the review of training developed by the working group at least once per academic year.
- Requires a joint working group to recommend procurement standards and training, with recommendations due by January 1, 2028.
- Requires a written report to the Legislature and certain legislative policy committees before executing a contract to procure a GenAI system for California Community Colleges and CSU, describing the evaluation and selection process, until procurement standards are adopted.  
Note: Full bill text is not available, which may limit this analysis.
