Summary

This bill regulates AI systems to prevent discrimination, mandates independent audits for high-risk systems, and allows enforcement by the attorney general.

Business Impact

If you develop or use high-risk AI systems in New York, you must undergo independent audits to ensure compliance or face legal action.

Key Provisions

- Regulates the development and use of certain AI systems to prevent algorithmic discrimination.
- Requires independent audits for high-risk AI systems, with the definition assumed to be in the bill text.
- Empowers the attorney general to enforce compliance.

Compliance Checklist

- Conduct independent audits of high-risk AI systems | Who: Developers and users of high-risk AI systems | Penalty: Legal action by the attorney general or private lawsuits
- Implement measures to prevent algorithmic discrimination | Who: All entities developing or using regulated AI systems | Penalty: Legal action by the attorney general or private lawsuits
