Insurance Companies, Agents, Brokers, Policies - As introduced, imposes requirements for health insurance issuers using artificial intelligence, algorithms, or other software for utilization review or utilization management functions. - Amends TCA Title 8, Chapter 27; Title 56 and Title 71.

Summary

This bill amends TCA Title 8, Chapter 27; Title 56 and Title 71, proposing requirements for health insurance issuers using AI for utilization review, though specifics are unclear without the full text.

If you use AI for utilization review in health insurance, you must comply with new requirements or face penalties.
