

# SB 2105 • Tennessee

Education - As introduced, requires each public charter school to publish the policy adopted by its governing board on the use of artificial intelligence by students, teachers, and staff for instructional and assignment purposes on its website; requires each local board of education to direct each school under its management and control to publish the policy adopted by the local board on the use of artificial intelligence by students, teachers, and staff for instructional and assignment purposes on the school's website. - Amends TCA Title 49.

## Summary

This bill mandates public charter schools and local education boards in Tennessee to publish AI usage policies on their websites, focusing on instructional and assignment purposes.

## Business Impact

If you operate a public charter school in Tennessee, you must publish your AI usage policy on your website or face potential compliance issues.

## Key Provisions

- Public charter schools must publish AI usage policies on their websites.
- Local education boards must direct schools to publish their AI policies.
- Policies must cover AI use by students, teachers, and staff for instructional and assignment purposes.
