

# SB 2105 • Tennessee

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 49, relative to education.

Introduced

Risk: Medium

Comprehensive

Last Action (Feb 05, 2026): Passed on Second Consideration, refer to Senate Education Committee

## Summary

This bill mandates public charter schools and local boards of education in Tennessee to publish AI usage policies for instructional purposes on their websites.

## Business Impact

If you operate a public charter school in Tennessee, you must publish your AI usage policy on your website or face potential compliance issues.

## Key Provisions

- Public charter schools must publish AI usage policies on their websites.
- Local boards of education must direct schools to publish AI policies.
- Policies must cover AI use by students, teachers, and staff for instructional purposes.

## Compliance Checklist

- Publish AI usage policy on website | Who: Public charter schools | Penalty: Potential scrutiny from educational authorities
- Direct schools to publish AI policies | Who: Local boards of education | Penalty: Potential scrutiny from educational authorities
