

SB 2618 • Tennessee

Computers and Electronic Processing - As introduced, requires the joint chairs of the artificial intelligence advisory council to publish their annual findings regarding the economic, labor, and ethical impacts of artificial intelligence on an appropriate page of the general assembly's website, in addition to the existing requirement to submit these reports to the governor and legislative speakers. - Amends TCA Title 4; Title 10; Title 16; Title 36; Title 37; Title 38; Title 39; Title 40; Title 45; Title 47; Title 48; Title 49; Title 53; Title 63; Title 67; Title 68 and Title 71.

Summary

The bill mandates the publication of annual findings on AI's impacts by the joint chairs of the artificial intelligence advisory council on the general assembly's website.

Business Impact

If you are involved in AI development or deployment in Tennessee, you must ensure your findings are published annually or face scrutiny.

Key Provisions

- Joint chairs of the artificial intelligence advisory council must publish annual findings.
- Findings must cover economic, labor, and ethical impacts of AI.
- Reports must be published on the general assembly's website.
- Existing requirement to submit reports to the governor and legislative speakers remains.
- Aims to enhance transparency regarding AI's societal impacts.
