AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 4; Title 5; Title 6; Title 7; Title 12; Title 39; Title 45; Title 47; Title 48; Title 50; Title 55; Title 61; Title 62; Title 65; Title 66; Title 67 and Title 68, relative to artificial intelligence.

Summary

This bill mandates a report on AI-related investigations under the Tennessee Consumer Protection Act from 2024 to 2025, to be submitted to specific committee chairs.

Business Impact

If you use AI in trade practices in Tennessee, you must prepare for potential investigations and reporting by July 1, 2026.

Key Provisions

- Requires a report on AI-related investigations under the Tennessee Consumer Protection Act.
- Covers investigations from January 1, 2024, to December 31, 2025.
- Report submission deadline is July 1, 2026.
- Report must be submitted to specific committee chairs.
- Allows for electronic submission of the report.
- Focuses on unfair or deceptive acts in trade or commerce.
- Amends multiple titles of the Tennessee Code Annotated.
