Summary

The bill mandates the Illinois Department on Aging to provide resources on scam calls and a hotline for reporting.

Business Impact

If you operate a business that may receive scam calls in Illinois, you must ensure your staff is aware of the resources available by the Department on Aging.

Key Provisions

- Requires the Department on Aging to provide updated resources on scam calls.
- Resources must include information on AI-driven predatory scam calls.
- Establishes a hotline for reporting scam calls.
