Summary

The bill allows the State Board of Education to provide guidance on curricula for teaching AI and emerging technologies.

Business Impact

If you operate a school in Illinois, you must adopt the State Board's guidance on AI education or risk falling behind in workforce preparation.

Key Provisions

- State Board of Education may provide guidance on curricula.
- Focus on teaching artificial intelligence, quantum computing, and other emerging technologies.
- Review of technology curricula from other states is required.
- Meetings with public and private sector stakeholders will be convened.
- Public comments will be allowed prior to finalizing the guidance.

Compliance Checklist

- Adopt the State Board's guidance on AI education | Who: School districts | Penalty: Potential loss of competitive edge in workforce preparation
- Participate in stakeholder meetings | Who: School administrators and educators | Penalty: Lack of input may lead to misalignment with workforce needs
