Summary

This bill mandates the Department of Economic and Community Development to create a plan for an AI small business program.

Business Impact

If you operate a small business in Connecticut, you must prepare to engage with the new AI program once established or risk missing out on potential support.

Key Provisions

- Requires the Department of Economic and Community Development to develop a plan for an AI small business program.
- Does not specify a timeline for implementation.
