Prohibits the use of most artificial intelligence in classrooms prior to high school except for AI used for diagnostic purposes or explicit instruction interventions for students with disabilities.

## Summary

This New York bill prohibits the use of most AI in classrooms prior to ninth grade, allowing exceptions for diagnostic purposes and interventions for students with disabilities.

## Business Impact

If you operate educational institutions in New York, you must refrain from using AI in classrooms before high school by July 1, 2026, or face regulatory scrutiny.

## Key Provisions

- Prohibits AI use in classrooms prior to ninth grade in New York.
- Allows AI for diagnostic purposes and interventions for students with disabilities.

## Compliance Checklist
