## Summary

Prohibits most AI in classrooms before high school, except for diagnostic or instructional use for students with disabilities.

## Business Impact

If you provide AI tools for education, ensure compliance with restrictions for pre-high school use.

## Key Provisions

- Prohibits most AI use in classrooms prior to high school.
- Allows AI for diagnostic purposes for students with disabilities.
- Permits AI for explicit instruction interventions for students with disabilities.

## Compliance Checklist

- Cease use of most AI technologies in classrooms prior to high school | Who: Educational institutions | Penalty: Potential penalties as determined by future regulations.
