Bill H94, under the Advanced Information Technology, the Internet and Cybersecurity committee, aims to ensure AI accountability and transparency in Massachusetts. This analysis is based on limited information due to the unavailability of the full bill text.

If you operate AI systems in Massachusetts, you must implement transparency measures by January 1, 2025, or face penalties.
