Summary

FL S0482 restricts government contracts with certain AI entities and requires parental consent for minors on chatbot platforms.

Business Impact

If you operate AI chatbots, you must obtain parental consent for minors by July 1, 2026, or face penalties.

Key Provisions

- Prohibits government contracts with certain AI entities under specific circumstances (s. 287.138)
- Mandates parental consent for minors on chatbot platforms (s. 501.9984)
- Requires bot operators to provide periodic notifications to users (s. 501.9985)

Compliance Checklist

- Obtain parental consent for minors using chatbot platforms | Who: Operators of companion chatbot platforms | Penalty: Civil penalties under the Florida Deceptive and Unfair Trade Practices Act
- Ensure compliance with contract restrictions regarding foreign entities | Who: Governmental entities | Penalty: Prohibition on extending or renewing contracts with specified entities
