### Summary

HB5045 criminalizes the nonconsensual creation and dissemination of digitally altered intimate images using AI in Connecticut.

### Business Impact

If you use AI to create or distribute intimate images, you must obtain consent or face criminal charges.

### Key Provisions

- Criminalizes nonconsensual creation of deepfake pornography.
- Prohibits dissemination of digitally altered intimate images without consent.

### Compliance Checklist

- Obtain explicit consent before creating or sharing altered images. | Who: Content creators and distributors. | Penalty: Criminal charges for non-compliance.
- Implement policies to ensure compliance with consent requirements. | Who: Businesses involved in digital content production. | Penalty: Potential legal repercussions.
