## An Act Prohibiting Health Insurers From Using Artificial Intelligence To Deny Health Insurance Claims.

### Summary

This bill prohibits health insurers from using artificial intelligence to deny health insurance claims.

### Business Impact

If you are a health insurer in Connecticut, you must stop using AI to deny claims immediately or face potential legal consequences.

### Key Provisions

- Prohibits health insurers from using AI to deny claims.
- Applies to all health insurers operating in Connecticut.
