An Act Prohibiting The Creation And Dissemination Of Intimate Images Generated Using Artificial Intelligence And Without Consent.

Summary

The bill prohibits the production and distribution of non-consensual deepfake intimate images and establishes unspecified criminal penalties for violations.

Business Impact

If you use AI to create images in Connecticut, you must ensure consent from individuals depicted or face criminal penalties.

Key Provisions

- Prohibits the creation of intimate images using AI without consent.
- Establishes criminal penalties for violations.
- Provides civil remedies for victims of non-consensual deepfake images.

Compliance Checklist

- Obtain consent from individuals before creating or distributing AI-generated intimate images. | Who: Businesses and individuals involved in image generation. | Penalty: Criminal penalties including fines or imprisonment.
- Implement measures to ensure compliance with consent requirements. | Who: Organizations using AI for image creation. | Penalty: Potential civil liability for damages.
