## An Act Requiring A Study Concerning Energy Efficiency Requirements For Artificial Intelligence Data Centers.

### Summary

This bill mandates quarterly reports on energy efficiency from AI data centers and requires regulations on their water and energy standards.

### Business Impact

If you operate an AI data center in Connecticut, you must submit quarterly energy efficiency reports or face potential regulatory penalties.

### Key Provisions

- Requires quarterly reports from AI data center operators on energy efficiency.
- Commissioner of Energy and Environmental Protection to adopt regulations on water and energy efficiency standards.
- Focuses on environmental impact of AI data centers.

### Compliance Checklist

- Submit quarterly energy efficiency reports | Who: Owners or operators of AI data centers | Penalty: Potential regulatory penalties for non-compliance
- Adopt and comply with new energy and water efficiency regulations | Who: Owners or operators of AI data centers | Penalty: Potential regulatory penalties for non-compliance
