## An Act Concerning Autonomous Vehicles.

## Summary

This bill allows for the testing of autonomous vehicles in Connecticut and mandates the DMV to regulate their use.

## Business Impact

If you operate autonomous vehicles in Connecticut, you must comply with DMV regulations for testing or face potential penalties.

## Key Provisions

- Allows the use of autonomous vehicles for testing purposes.
- Requires the DMV to adopt regulations concerning the use of autonomous vehicles.
- Mandates a study on how autonomous vehicles can increase mobility for persons with disabilities.
