An Act Requiring Certain Retail Business Establishments To Display Signs Regarding The Use Of Facial Recognition Technology.

Summary

Retail establishments must display signs about facial recognition technology use, effective July 1, 2016.

Business Impact

If you operate a retail business in Connecticut using facial recognition, you must display a sign by July 1, 2016, or face a \$100 fine.

Key Provisions

- Retail establishments must display a sign about facial recognition technology.
- Sign must be at least 8 inches high and 10 inches long.
- Failure to display the sign results in a \$100 fine.

Compliance Checklist

- Display a sign about facial recognition technology use | Who: Retail business establishments | Penalty: \$100 fine for non-compliance
