HB1782 establishes the AI Education Innovation Act, creating the AI Education Innovation Revolving Fund and the AI Education Advisory Council in Oklahoma.

Business Impact

If you operate in Oklahoma, you must engage with the AI Education Advisory Council by November 1, 2023, or face funding ineligibility.

Key Provisions

- Establishes the AI Education Innovation Act.
- Creates the AI Education Innovation Revolving Fund to support AI education.
- Forms the AI Education Advisory Council.
- Effective date specified in the bill text.
