Use of Artificial Intelligence in Psychological, Clinical, Counseling, and Therapy Services

Enacted

Risk: Medium

Effective: Jul 01, 2026 | Last Action (Mar 13, 2026): Died in Health Policy

Summary

This bill prohibits the use of artificial intelligence in psychology and counseling services, without detailing specific exceptions for administrative tasks.

Business Impact

If you provide psychological or counseling services in Florida, you must refrain from using AI in practice by July 1, 2026, or face potential penalties.

Key Provisions

- Defines 'artificial intelligence' in the context of psychological services.
- Prohibits the use of AI in the practice of psychology and counseling.

Compliance Checklist

- Cease the use of AI in therapeutic practices. | Who: Licensed psychologists and counselors. | Penalty: Potential penalties for non-compliance.
- Obtain written consent for recording therapy sessions using AI. | Who: Licensed professionals and registered interns. | Penalty: Potential penalties for non-compliance.
