Summary

The bill establishes the Artificial Intelligence in Higher Education Study Group to assess AI's impact on areas like teaching and privacy, recommending best practices by December 2026.

Business Impact

If you operate in higher education in Florida, you must prepare for AI governance recommendations by December 1, 2026, or risk non-compliance.

Key Provisions

- Creation of the Artificial Intelligence in Higher Education Study Group.
- Membership includes faculty, education board representatives, AI experts, and student representatives.
- Group to examine AI's impact on teaching, learning support, advising, grading, accessibility, research, and privacy, and recommend best practices.
- Report due by December 1, 2026, to the Governor and Legislature.
- Group to solicit input from various stakeholders.
- Section expires on December 31, 2026.
