## Summary

The bill authorizes the use of autonomous technology to operate vehicles in autonomous mode, designating this technology as the operator for legal compliance.

## Business Impact

If you operate autonomous vehicles in Florida, you must ensure your technology complies with traffic laws or face legal penalties.

## Key Provisions

- Authorizes the use of autonomous technology to operate vehicles in autonomous mode.
- Designates autonomous technology as the operator for compliance with traffic laws.
- Confirms that autonomous technology is considered validly licensed.
