Summary

Speculative analysis of AB2047 based on official description; full bill text not reviewed.

Business Impact

If you produce 3D printers in California, you must block firearm printing or face penalties.

Key Provisions

- Add Title 21.1 to Part 4 Division 3 of the Civil Code.
- Add Section 29187 to the Penal Code.
- Specific mandates on 3D printer manufacturers and penalties for firearm printing cannot be confirmed without the full bill text.
