## Summary

This bill allows the operation of autonomous vehicles on public roads and mandates a safety report from the DHSMV.

## Business Impact

If you operate autonomous vehicles in Florida, you must comply with safety regulations and report requirements by the specified deadlines or face penalties.

## Key Provisions

- Allows operation of autonomous motor vehicles on public roads.
- Mandates DHSMV to prepare a report on safe operation.
- Requires submission of the report to the Legislature.
