Summary

This bill congratulates former State Trooper Sergeant Kenneth E. Branham II on his retirement after over 24 years of service.

Business Impact

If you use AI for prior authorizations, you must disclose this to enrollees or face disciplinary actions.

Key Provisions

- Addition of Article 25 to Chapter 71, Title 38
- Requirement for insurers to consider specific circumstances when using AI for prior authorizations
- Mandatory disclosure of AI usage to enrollees, specifics not confirmed
- Disciplinary actions for violations, specifics not confirmed

Compliance Checklist

- Consider enrollee's medical history and clinical circumstances in AI decisions | Who: Health insurers | Penalty: Disciplinary actions for violations
- Certify AI compliance annually to the Department of Insurance | Who: Health insurers | Penalty: Potential corrective measures or penalties for non-compliance
- Make disclosures about AI usage to enrollees | Who: Health insurers | Penalty: Disciplinary actions for violations
