Requesting The Department Of Education To Develop Artificial Intelligence Literacy Curricula Plans And Programs For Use In Public Schools.

Introduced

Risk: Low

Study/Task Force

Last Action (Mar 19, 2026): Referred to EDU/LBT.

Summary

The bill requests the Department of Education to create AI literacy curricula for public schools to enhance students' understanding of AI technologies, with no penalties for non-compliance.

Business Impact

If you operate a public school in Hawaii, you must prepare to implement AI literacy programs by the 2026-2027 school year or face educational gaps.

Key Provisions

- Develop AI literacy curricula plans and programs for public schools.
- Include definitions and key concepts of artificial intelligence.
- Address ethical implications and best practices for AI use.
- Examine innovations in AI technology.
- Analyze AI's relation to the state's history and culture.
- Submit developed curricula to the Legislature by a specified deadline.
